What is the difference between the three types of General English courses?

Study Tours

Study tours are a good way for groups from non-English speaking countries to combine a short intensive period of learning English with an enriching tour experiencing Australia's lifestyle and culture generally.

Ability Education provides English instruction for groups of all kinds. We work with tour group organisers to ensure that English instruction matches each group's needs, including developing structured classes for visitors with special interests.

Study tour classes can be organised for full time sessions totalling 25 hours a week or part time, 17 hours a week. Our classes especially focus on helping tour members improve their English speaking and listening skills, with an emphasis on practical conversational English. Also, we provide insights on Australian life as they affect communication.

Importantly, we assist with arrangements for a range of excursions to complement the English language study component of tours. Locally based excursions can take place in mornings or afternoons – before or after the English tuition component of the study tour. With longer travel, a full day excursion may best be held either on a weekday or, alternatively, on a Saturday or Sunday, our study-free days.
